

Course: BusPlanner as a Management Tool

Duration: 1 day

Overview

Managers are required to use BusPlanner as more than just a route planning tool. This course will teach managers searching concepts as well as useful "out-of-the-box" searches that may be helpful on a daily basis. Example course exercises include finding information in BusPlanner when only partial information is available, finding routes that use a section of road and advance theme management. This course will also review understanding the overall capabilities of BusPlanner, using the analysis tools and how to do financial calculations and contracts.

Goals

- Advanced theme management
- Understanding of financial calculation in BusPlanner including an introduction to contracts
- Use of analysis tools to determine overall health of database
- Use of SQL to conduct common "out-of-the-box" searches

Audience

This course is designed for managers and administrators who would like build on their existing BusPlanner knowledge.

Prerequisites and recommendations

Students should have 6 months BusPlanner experience.
